

Life on the Rocks will be hosting a few events this fall, so be sure to join us if you can.



Working Dog Foundation Turns



Support animals provide aid in school, homes, and to law enforcement

A decade ago, Cohasset was looking to add a K-9 unit to its Police Department.

Cohasset resident and animal lover Trish Morse helped the chief put together a presentation supporting the need for such a program, telling him, "if you need any help raising money, let me know."

That's how the Cohasset Working Dog Foundation began.


With Morse's outreach and drive, what started as a small, volunteer fundraising effort grew into an official public charity, today marking its tenth anniversary with a board of directors, a mission statement and official 501(c)(3) non-profit status.

"Funding through the CWDF is the lifeblood of the entire K-9 unit," says Cohasset's Chief Bill Quigley. "Having a K-9 program adds a layer of protection for residents, visitors, and officers. Without the support of CWDF, the K-9 unit would be in jeopardy and likely dissolved."

Expanding the CDWF mission with Therapy Dogs and Service Dogs

Once the first K-9 dog, "Erik," and his handler, police officer Patrick Reardon, were trained and aiding the department in missing person cases and drug tracking, the board looked to expand its mission.

"I envisioned an organization that would support all kinds of working dogs, including comfort dogs and service dogs," said Trish. "The more I



So in 2012, resident Mara Stefan volunteered her rescue lab "Sophie" to be trained for work as a therapy dog. With her calm and tolerant disposition, Sophie was a natural and soon became a weekly visitor to Willcutt Commons and a regular "Reading Partner" at the Paul Pratt

The library program has grown to include a rotating group of four therapy dogs and their volunteer handlers. "It has been an honor to work with CWDF for the past decade," says Sharon Moody, children's librarian. "Over 1,000 children with various abilities have gained confidence and comfort from CWDF's Reading Partners program. It gives them the opportunity and time they need to work on their skills, whether it's reading, emotional



support or overcoming fear of dogs. It's such a special partnership."

A one-time "Read with the Dogs" field trip for a single Deer Hill 3rd grade class was so popular it turned into an annual 3rd-grade event — and ultimately launched a highly successful weekly "Reading Rovers" literacy program, which today brings three therapy dogs each week to Deer Hill students.

Reading Rover "Taco," a chocolate lab, visits each week with his mom, Michelle Grady. "One librarian remarked to me that she had never heard one particular child talk that much after visiting with Taco," says Michelle. "Moments like that make our day."

"You would think it impossible for three active dogs to lie calmly in a small space while a whole classroom

of students buzz about and lie on them and read, but it totally works," says Trish. "Our volunteer teams are very experienced, and the dogs really love coming to Deer Hill, so it is a joy for everyone."

The therapy dog program has worked with more than 20 volunteer teams in various venues all over town.

In 2013, CWDF began raising money for the purchase and training of a Service Dog for a resident with a disability. (These specially trained dogs can cost upwards of \$20,000.) The first grant brought "Parker" to Cohasset to provide mobility assistance to a young Cohasset girl.

After his arrival, Parker continued training with Trish, and with the generous blessing of his family, Parker has expanded his working dog repertoire to become a therapy dog and an ambassador to the Cohasset Working Dog Foundation. The Cohasset Working Dog Foundation's Service Dog Grant is for \$10,000 and any Cohasset resident with a disability may apply.

Parker now does educational demonstrations all over the South Shore, teaching children and adults about the many ways that working dogs can be used to help humans. "I've had a lot of great jobs, but volunteering as Parker's guide and therapy dog handler is truly one of the greatest joys of my life," says Trish.

Cats and Chickens?

In the fall of 2019, CWDF introduced a new species: A therapy cat named "Dollywood." Pre-Covid, Dolly began visiting Laurelwood at the Pinehills in Plymouth, bringing feline joy to the seniors there.

During Covid, CWDF found opportunities for therapy animal work in some non-traditional settings. Parker made weekly visits to a neighborhood learning pod of first and second graders, and to the Norwell Outdoor School, A Silkie chicken named "Heaven" and her three baby chicks also visited both schools for the children to learn about and hold.

Have you ever thought your dog would make a great therapy dog?

The Cohasset Working Dog Foundation funds orientation work-Dogs of Massachusetts. CWDF also funds advanced AKC obedience training for its volunteers, including AKC Canine Good Citizen and AKC handlers to respond to personal and community crises on the South Shore.







A new director for Cohasset's SSCC Nursery School

When SSCC nursery school director Ann Madden assembled her staff to make an announcement, the news was met with shocked silence.

After 15 years at the helm, and nearly four decades working at the preschool, Ann was planning to step down this coming school year.

Who could possibly replace her? Slowly, all eyes turned to Jamey Kupsc, a Cohasset native who has raised her own two teen sons in town and has spent over a decade teaching on the nursery staff.

"We all, as a group felt like somebody has to step up because we need to keep Ann's legacy going," Jamey recalls. "I was in the best position schoolwise and kidwise to be able to do it."

"I was thrilled when Jamey stepped up," says Ann.
"I couldn't think of anybody better to take the spot.
Jamey is always up for a challenge."

The two women recently sat down with *Life on the Rocks* on the cusp of a transition plan approved by state overseers as the mentor trains and hands over the reins to her protege this spring.

Ann came to the SSCC nursery school 38 years ago, a year out of college, and started working with Jean Brett as her mentor, whom she credits with showing her how to work with children.

Then, 15 years ago, retiring director Sheila O'Neill pulled Ann aside and encouraged her to take over the director role.

"I hope I've expressed it over the years, but I loved every minute," Ann says. "For me, work is love made visible. That's why I'm happy to pass the torch to my friend."

Ann, who lives in Scituate, has been married 40 years, has raised three children, and is now a grandmother of two. "I feel like I have one more big thing in me and I'm not sure what it is," Ann says. "That may be writing a children's book or volunteering at the library, or enjoying more downtime flower arranging and entertaining. It's time to think about giving back."

Because of her longevity, Ann has found herself frequently teaching the children of her former pupils. "You just have these

pictures of the children frozen in time," she says. "To see them grown up and come back to school, it's a nice continuity that I don't think you can replicate. I'm very happy to have been part of the story that is the Community Center."

From her vantage point, are preschoolers today any different from a generation ago? "The things around them are different, but children are essentially the same," Ann says. "They need the same basic things: to be seen, they need to be heard, and to be trusted. The amount of learning and growth that goes on between when they walk in the door until the time they leave is amazing. And I've been fortunate enough to watch it. It's been a great ride."

One of Ann's signature accomplishments is instituting an annual art show, where the students pick a theme, from planets to "Hickory Dickory Dock," and produce original artwork. "When the art show comes, the kids are definitely very proud of it and they can explain the process that goes into the art," Ann says.

Jamey plans to continue the school's mission of bolstering children's esteem and preparing them for a lifetime of learning.


"I think our philosophy, and the way that we view children, are solid," says Jamey. "That children are valued, individual beings, and the best thing we can do every day is to make them feel confident, make them feel appreciated and understood, so they take that with them throughout their school careers."

"I love it because it's really customizable," Allison says. "It gives the aesthetician the opportunity to look at you under a good light and to talk about what concerns you might have."

Allison and her partner Lindsey Morningstar, both family nurse practitioners, have just celebrated the medispa's one-year anniversary in operation on North Street right in downtown Hingham.

The two childhood friends and neighbors grew up together (see pic) and opened this second location to best serve their South Shore clientele.

Behind the soothing grey and lavender decor are two highly-trained medical professionals bringing some of the most advanced skin treatments to the area.

"My passion is women's health," says Allison. "I really believe in building relationships with my clients – this is more of a shared decision in regards to what someone's goals are over time, within budget, to create a treatment plan that will get them where they want. Sometimes, people will tippytoe into one treatment, and then come back for a follow-up and say, okay, what's next?"

The medispa offers a wide array of offerings, including microneedling with platelet-rich plasma (PRP) -- a process that extracts a patient's own blood, spins it for ten minutes in a centrifuge, and injects the plasma

back into the skin, supplying healing and collagen-building properties.

"This is one of my favorite treatments to use for hair restoration, joint, and scar repair," says Lindsey. "They are very effective for these issues and it can truly transform a patient's self-esteem." Another microneedling treatment, the Virtue RF, is a non-surgical skin-tightening device that utilizes radio frequency to generate collagen for gradual skin tightening.

For the needle-averse, there are alternatives: chemical peels and medical-grade skincare product lines. Certain laser treatments are best done in the fall and winter, such as laser hair removal, and treatment for spider veins (sclerotherapy) or sunspots.

The medispa is also one of a handful of local providers of the O-SHOT -- vaginal rejuvenation therapy that aids dryness or reduced libido in women of a certain age. Another unique offering is non-invasive body contouring treatment, using RF devices such as the VelaShape III and the new truSculpt iD, which touts a 24% fat reduction rate in as little as 15 minutes.

"People are happy they can get the definition they want in areas like the abs resistant to diet and exercise with only one session," explains lead aesthetician Jaime Foreman.

Of course, the medispa also offers traditional dermal fillers and Botox

injections for both men and women of all ages, often prompted by a life trigger such as a high school reunion, milestone birthday, or a divorce. The shift to gazing back at ourselves all day on Zoom meetings has convinced those who never

considered treatment before.

"People come in saying, "I don't want to look like I've had anything done, but I want to look refreshed – I want to look like the best version of myself," Allison says. "The most rewarding experience is when someone says, 'You have given me the confidence back that I thought I lost."

While some clients "shout it from the rooftops," others only admit they've done work to their closest friends. Those confessions give many the "freedom and permission" to book a consultation.

The Ultimate SDOIT

Can Cohasset Field a Frisbee Team? By Stephen Sheffield

As the father of two teenage boys and a resident of our beautiful town, I believe the youth here could benefit from an alternative to high-pressure, ultra-competitive suburban teams sports. So six years ago, I pitched the sport of Ultimate Frisbee to the Cohasset Recreation Department.

I have played ultimate frisbee casually for most of my life, beginning in high school in the early 1980s. Ultimate Frisbee is a fun, highly athletic, low-pressure, co-ed sport that students can play for the rest of their lives.

The idea was met with enthusiasm – practices started and word got out. Next thing I knew, I was contacted by a group of Cohasset High School

sophomore boys who had been casually playing amongst themselves after school. They asked me to be their coach and teach them the sport.

I jumped at the chance.

Soon, we had a full-fledged Cohasset Ultimate Club Team and I convinced the South Shore High School Ultimate League to let us in. Three years later, we had a highly competitive team, placing well in regional tournaments. I later was informed that five members of our team had gone on to college and joined up with their school teams.

However, the pandemic decimated many high school sports programs, and our fledgling Ultimate Frisbee community was especially hard hit. I am now hoping to rebuild the team, starting at middle school age and regenerating interest at the High School level. This spring was very promising, with two programs running, one with the middle school and another with Cohasset Rec.

How is Ultimate Frisbee Played?

Ultimate Frisbee is a high-energy sport that combines features of basketball, soccer, American football, and a flying disc (Frisbee). Ultimate is played on a field with seven players on two teams. The teams compete for points until one team wins by scoring a predetermined total (usually 13 or 15).

The rules of Ultimate Frisbee are a unique blend of sports. To score, a player must catch the flying disc in the end zone. When a player catches the disc outside the end zone, they cannot run with it but must use a pivot foot and pass the disc to one of

their teammates.

Players then have 10 seconds to throw the disc or a turnover occurs. The movement of the disc is similar to the way the ball moves in socceroften it is passed sideways, or even backward, before going forwards again. Ultimate is a non-contact sport, meaning you cannot hit or foul another player. However, the flying disc can be intercepted.

Most notably, Ultimate is actually played without referees, even at the highest levels. This is due to something called "Spirit of the Game," which places a responsibility on each player to uphold the values of respect and fair play. Players call fouls through the game themselves, discussing the alleged foul, coming to a consensus, and continuing on.

In this new post-pandemic age, a fun, fast, no-contact sport might just be what we need. If this appeals to you, join us to help make it a reality.




